This privacy policy describes the information practices of the mobile application of UnicLog.

Overview

UnicLog is not in the business of selling personal information. We believe the best way to ensure your private and personal information is protected is to make every effort to ensure that we do not receive or collect your private personal information in the first place.

Collection & Use

We are committed to ensure that UnicLog users' private and personal information remains private. As such, we do NOT collect user-identifiable data, browsing history, or IP addresses when you browse with UnicLog.

UnicLog does NOT employ cookies, which is a small piece of data sent from a website and stored on the user's computer or mobile device by the user's web browser while the user is browsing. Cookies were designed to be a reliable mechanism for websites to remember stateful personal information (such as items added in the shopping cart in an online store) or to record the user's browsing activity (including clicking particular buttons, logging in, or recording which pages were visited in the past). They can also be used to remember arbitrary pieces of information that the user

previously entered into form fields such as names, addresses, passwords, and credit card numbers.
